Administrator Tanner read the report; set service poles, cleaned out old digger truck and little bucket truck prep for listing for sale, started south park electric pedestal project, hooked up new electric service for newly built home at 830 W. Colorado, Chris and Chance attended Mesa Hotline School in Grand Junction. mowing and weed eating parks, finished north park sprinkler manifold, installed new sprinkler in south park, opened restrooms at RV Park, working on smoothing alleys, began street sweeping and will notify public of the sweeping scheduled, filled pool and ready for opening, sprayed and mowed sewer lagoon. Administrator Report. ServePro of Garden City, Kansas inspected the Fire Dept Building to draw up a quote to clean up the mold. A quote for a leak survey to pin point loss of water was provided in the Board packet; Tanner explained the need for this due to multiple summer months with exceptional high water loss.
