

ORDINANCE NO. 434

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS OF MONEY TO DEFRAID EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO.

WHEREAS the Town has unforeseen expenses in excess of its 2006 budget; and

WHEREAS the Town has unappropriated fund balances; and

WHEREAS the Town has sufficient cash on hand to meet these expenses; now

THEREFORE be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado:

Section 1. The 2006 appropriation for the General Fund is hereby increased from \$322,822 to \$346,822.
