

ORDINANCE NO. 448

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2008, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF HOLLY, PROWERS COUNTY, COLORADO FOR THE 2008 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town of Holly has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on November 7, 2007, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is \$54,865 and;

WHEREAS, the 2008 valuation for assessment for the Town of Holly as certified by the County Assessor is \$1,900,670;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF HOLLY, PROWERS COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Holly during the 2008 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 28.866 mill upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 2008.

Section 2. That the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Prowers County, Colorado, the mill levy for the Town of Holly as hereinabove determined and set.
