

ORDINANCE NO. 449

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAID EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED IN THE UTILITY FUND FOR THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO, FOR THE YEAR 2007.

WHEREAS, the Town has unforeseen expenses in excess of its 2007 Utility Fund Budget due to a Federally declared disaster (blizzard) and a State of Colorado declared disaster (tornado); now

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO:

THAT, the appropriation for the Utility Fund is hereby increased from \$1,194,290 to \$1,610,300 from unbudgeted reserves.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that an emergency exists, and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and it shall become effective upon signing.
