

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, It has pleased the Creator to call from among us our friends and neighbors, Dolores Burns and Rosemary Rosales; and

WHEREAS, While bowing to the Divine Will, we recognize their presences are very much absent and missed within the community; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Holly Board of Trustees and Mayor have endeavored to proclaim a most worthy statement regarding the first anniversary of the Holly Tornado Disaster of March 28, 2007; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Holly Board of Trustees and Mayor join with the Residents of the Town of Holly in recognizing March 28, 2008 as a day of Acknowledgement and Remembrance.

NOW THEREFORE, I, JERRY SMITH, Mayor of Holly, **PROCLAIM** that in recognition of the memory of Dolores Burns and Rosemary Rosales, all American flags flown within the corporate limits of the Town of Holly on March 28, 2008 shall be displayed at half-staff; and

FURTHER, I PROCLAIM THAT each flag displayed at half-staff shall be hoisted to full-staff for an instant, and then lowered to half-staff. Likewise, **I PROCLAIM THAT** when it is lowered at the end of the day, it is to be hoisted to full-staff for an instant, and then lowered.

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED THAT these declarations be spread upon the minutes in regular meeting of the Board of Trustees. **SO BE IT.**
