**A STATEMENT OF RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO IN SUPPORT OF SIGNAGE PLACED AT THE TOWN'S LIMITS ON COLORADO HIGHWAY 50 HONORING FORMER COLORADO GOVERNOR ROY ROMER.**

WHEREAS, the community of Holly wishes to honor former Colorado Governor Roy Romer; and

WHEREAS, the board of Trustees joins with the community in honoring Governor Romer's position in the history of Holly; and

WHEREAS, the board of Trustees has determined that the proper acknowledgement is the placement of signage at the Town's limits on Colorado Highway 50; now

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that our community leaders will support the recommendation to the State of Colorado Department of Transportation that signage should be placed at the Town's limits on Colorado Highway 50 honoring former Colorado Governor Roy Romer; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the signage should speak to the importance of Holly's place in Colorado history as the childhood home of former Colorado Governor Roy Romer; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that said signage should impart the message with the following verbiage:

WELCOME TO HOLLY, COLORADO

HOMETOWN OF GOVERNOR ROY ROMER
