### **A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO OPPOSING PINON CANYON ARMY MANEUVER SITE EXPANSION**

WHEREAS, the people of the Town of Holly have carefully considered the significant negative impact of any expansion of the Army's Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site; and

WHEREAS, the people of the Town of Holly are aware of the fragile economy of the rural ranching and farming community; and

WHEREAS, the people of the Town of Holly depend upon ranching and agricultural production in the area to sustain a viable economy; and

WHEREAS, the Army utilizes substantial acreage amounting to over ten million acres for its training and warfare exercises in the United States; and

WHEREAS, any further removal of land from agriculture production and property tax rolls will have a devastating impact on the Town of Holly, County of Prowers, and the State of Colorado; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly hereby expresses its strong opposition to any expansion efforts of the Army or the Department of Defense for its Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site.
