

RESOLUTION 2007-7

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A REQUEST TO CHANGE THE ACCESS CATEGORY OF STATE HIGHWAY 50 FROM 11th STREET TO THE JUNCTION OF STATE HIGHWAY 89 IN THE TOWN LIMITS OF HOLLY, COLORADO

Whereas, the present access category for State Highway 50 within the incorporated limits of the Town of Holly from 11th Street to the Junction of State Highway 89 is Regional Highway (RA); and

WHEREAS, Section Two of the Colorado State Highway Access Code (1998) requires the “appropriate local authority” to request changes in the assigned Categories of State Highway by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, at the recommendation of the Town Administrator, acknowledges that the existing and planned developments along both sides of SH-50 from 11th Street to the Junction of SH-89, are more representative of urban and residential development than sparse development along an open highway system.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Request for Category Change. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly hereby supports a request to the Colorado Department of Transportation to change the access category for State Highway 50, between 11th Street and the Junction of State Highway 89, from Regional Highway (RA) to Non-Rural Arterial (NR-C). Staff is hereby authorized to submit such a request to the Colorado Department of Transportation.
