

## RESOLUTION 2007-9

### **A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY ESTABLISHING RENTAL RATES FOR THE GRANT McCORMICK MEMORIAL BALL PARK RECREATIONAL VEHICLE (RV) SPACES**

**WHEREAS**, the Town owns property, specifically known as the Grant McCormick Memorial Ballpark, located at West Highway 50, which is primarily a municipal recreational area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town was devastated by a tornado on March 28, 2007 which requires rebuilding and restructuring the Town's infrastructures and the survivor's homes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Holly is in need of temporary housing sites, initially to be used by contractors who are involved in the rebuilding of the Town of Holly and its structures, and by volunteers who have come to the aid of the townspeople of Holly.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly that:

Section 1: Through the good graces of other cities and municipalities throughout the State of Colorado and the volunteer spirit of those cities and towns, the Town of Holly has brought into being a recreational vehicle park for the purpose of accommodating building contractors. The recreational vehicles spaces will be rented to contractors for \$15.00 per day.

Section 2: As a result of the tornado disaster the Town of Holly has received the services of numerous volunteer groups and individuals. Volunteers who come to the aid of the townspeople for the purpose of rebuilding the Town of Holly will incur no charge.

Section 3: The daily fee of \$25.00 will be charged to all other travelers and visitors to the Town of Holly who wish to avail themselves of this city service.
