

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-5

A RESOLUTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF BUFFALO STREET IN THE FIRST ADDITION OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 31-15-702 provides that the Governing body of a municipality may vacate any street or any portion of a street; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly has determined that the easternmost 151 feet of Buffalo Street in the First Addition of the Town of Holly, Colorado will better serve the Holly School District RE-3 of Holly, Colorado by its vacate; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly has declared the vacate of the easternmost 151 feet of Buffalo Street in the First Addition of the Town of Holly, Colorado necessary to the safety, wellbeing and welfare of the students of the Holly School District RE-3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado that:

1. The easternmost 151 feet of Buffalo Street in the First Addition of Holly, Colorado is hereby vacated, except all utility easements, if any, situate, lying and being in the County of Prowers and the State of Colorado.
2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
