

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2009-3**

### **A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO SUPPORTING THE PROMOTION OF THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF THE CENSUS COUNT IN 2010**

**WHEREAS**, the next Decennial Census will be taken in the year 2010; and political representation to the United States House of Representatives and state legislatures is determined by the Decennial Census, and the Town of Holly recognizes the equal importance of each resident in the 2010 Census count; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Holly has agreed to be a local government entity in partnership with the United States Bureau of the Census; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Holly understands that its primary role in this partnership is to use an existing structure or program to implement local promotion activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the role of the local government is to bridge all gaps between the community and the Census Bureau on geographic matters, outreach activities, and information.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly that:

1. The Town of Holly Board of Trustees hereby authorizes participation with the United States Bureau of the Census for the purpose of fostering local promotion activities pertaining to the 2010 Census.
2. The Town of Holly Board of Trustees hereby authorizes Town of Holly staff to inform, motivate, and educate the town's residents in the necessity and importance of their rapid response and participation in Census 2010.
3. The Town of Holly Board of Trustees recognizes its role in communicating to the community of the many ways census data are used to obtain funding for essential town services and programs.
