ORDINANCE NO. 523

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO CLARIFYING THE MANNER OF STREET NUMBERS

WHEREAS, the Town's main corridor streets are Highway 50 (running East and West) and Main Street (running North and South); and

WHEREAS, to avoid any confusion in the future, the Board of Trustees is desirous of codifying the address numbering scheme to be used within properties located in the Town; and

WHEREAS, uniform numbering assists firefighters, first responders, and law enforcement personnel in responding to emergency calls.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: Residences or businesses located on streets running North and South lying North of Highway 50 with fronts facing West shall be numbered with even ascending numbers.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: Residences or businesses located on streets running North and South lying North of Highway 50 with fronts facing East shall be numbered with odd ascending numbers.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: Residences or businesses located on streets running North and South lying South of Highway 50 with fronts facing West shall be numbered with odd ascending numbers.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: Residences or businesses located on streets running North and South lying South of Highway 50 with fronts facing East shall be numbered with even ascending numbers.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: Residences or businesses located on streets running East and West lying North of Highway 50 with fronts facing North shall be numbered with even ascending numbers.

<u>SECTION 6</u>: Residences or businesses located on streets running East and West lying North of Highway 50 with fronts facing South shall be numbered with odd ascending numbers.

<u>SECTION 7</u>: Residences or businesses located on streets running East and West lying South of Highway 50 with fronts facing North shall be numbered with even ascending numbers.

<u>SECTION 8</u>: Residences or businesses located on streets running East and West lying South of Highway 50 of Main Street with fronts facing South shall be numbered with odd ascending numbers.

<u>SECTION 9</u>: Streets running East and West, lying North of Highway 50 shall have numbers ascending in a Northerly direction from Highway 50.

<u>SECTION 10</u>: Streets running East and West, lying South of Highway 50 shall have numbers ascending in a Southerly direction from Highway 50.

SECTION 11: Streets running North and South, lying East of Main Street shall have numbers ascending in an Easterly direction from Main Street. SECTION 12: Streets running North and South, lying West of Main Street shall have numbers ascending in a Westerly direction from main Street. SECTION 13: The numbering of guest houses, upstairs living units in commercial units and other types of multi-units within the same location shall be numbered in accordance with Section 1 through 12 of this Ordinance, but may have the use of "_____.5" or some other decimal digit as a further designation. SECTION 14: If there are multiple connected lots, then the address to be used shall be the central spot of the connecting location. SECTION 15: Future assignment of new addresses will be subject to numbering in a manner consistent with this Ordinance. SECTION 16: The Town Clerk shall have authority to assign street address numbers consistent with this Ordinance subject only to review by the Board of Trustees pursuant to Section 19 below. SECTION 17: All current "in-use" addresses shall remain as currently stated. In the event that a discrepancy is discovered, the numbering shall be implemented in accordance with Sections 15 and 19 of this Ordinance. SECTION 18: Disputes concerning duplicate requests for address assignments, or disputes concerning current use of duplicate addresses shall be resolved by assigning the address to the first party to factually demonstrate the use of that disputed address. This priority shall be determined by the Board of Trustees pursuant to Section 19 herein. SECTION 19: In the event of any dispute over the numbering of residences or business said dispute shall be considered by the Town's Board of Trustees, after giving notice to all involved parties. Thereafter, any dispute shall be resolved by a vote of the Board of Trustees. Said resolution shall therefore be conclusive. INTRODUCED, READ, AND ORDERED PUBLISHED THIS 5th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2018.
