A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO ADOPTING THE SOUTHEAST COLORADO ALL-HAZARDS REGION/REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Southeast Colorado All-Hazards Region/Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan was developed to reduce future losses caused by natural hazards within Prowers County, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires jurisdictions to prepare and adopt a Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan every five years in order to be eligible for future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, Prowers County provided in-kind contributions in developing the plan, and other funds were used to hire a consultant to develop and guide Prowers County and the Southeast Region through the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Planning process including input from citizens, special districts, government staff, and experts in the various emergency response disciplines; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency have reviewed the Southeast Colorado All-Hazards Region/Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon adoption by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Holly, a Statutory Town within Prowers County, State of Colorado is included in the All-Hazards Region/Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan at ACTION ITEM #18;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado that its adoption of the Southeast Colorado All-Hazards Region/Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan is in the best interest of the safety and wellbeing of the residents of the town.
