RESOLUTION 2020-3

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY AUTHORIZING RATE ADJUSTMENTS TO ALL CLASSIFICATIONS OF THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT; AND SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION 2011-3

WHEREAS, the Town of Holly cannot maintain a landfill which complies with Federal Sub Title D and Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment regulations requiring a facility waiver, ground water monitoring, cell liner and closure and post-closure; at a cost that is not economically feasible for the Town of Holly; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Holly must contract a private solid waste hauler to pick up and haul solid waste to a landfill that either complies with Colorado regulations or is out of state; and

WHEREAS, the Town will have to cease operations of the landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Town has not increased landfill (now tipping fees) or garbage rates since 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Town has not increased dumpster rates since 2011; and

WHEREAS, the department's rates do not allow sufficient reserves for future capital needs or expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the town provides water, sewer and electric service to all residents, therefore, it is in the best interest of the town to provide garbage service to all town residents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado, a municipal corporation, that the following garbage and tipping fee rates are hereby adopted and will become effective for the first billing period commencing after March 31, 2020:
